Progressive verbs = a form of " \underline{to} \underline{be} " + an \underline{action} verb with $\underline{-ing}$.

Forms of "to be"

Used to tell what a **subject** is doing, feeling, or simply is.

Ex: The girl is singing.

Ex: They are happy.

Ex: It is cold outside.

Don't forget, your subject and verb must agree.
